All dairy cattle in Classes 1-19 must be bonafide property of the registered owner and must be registered in the stud book or appendix section of the relevant breed society, or held by the exhibitor under a written and recorded lease at the time of entry.

NOTE : Exhibitor/s to be current Members of their respective breed Society/Assn. of the dairy breeds in this book. Refer Rule No. 6. All Cattle to be tied up if required. "Dry Cow" must have calved at least 9 months or more prior to date of show or a cow not giving any milk but in calf.

REMAIN ON THE GROUNDS—REFER RULES 8 & 28.**

BROOM RAPE : Please see Rule 31.

- No milk is to be disposed of on the grounds or into drains or surroundings. \$100 Fine and Disqualification to Committee rulings.
- Animals not to be left tied at wash bay unattended.
- To ease queuing at wash bay, prepare animals before show day.
- All straw, hay and manure must be collected and taken away.
