SECTION REGULATIONS:

- Open to all home and business gardens, located within the Strathalbyn portion of the Alexandrina Council.
- Rural and Urban gardens are eligible.
- When entering, please state which town or district you wish to be entered in, out of the following areas:- Strathalbyn, Langhorne Creek, Milang, Clayton, Ashbourne, Finnis and Woodchester
- Please nominate garden on entry form and forward to convenor, together with entry fee by closing date.
- If property is hard to locate, submit plan with entry form.
- Out of the nine classes listed below, the best garden in each category will receive a special certificate and rosette. On being judged the best garden of its class, the garden will then be eligible to enter in the Champion garden of the Strathalbyn District.

Entry Fee: \$5.00 per garden (not per class)

Judging 2 days : Saturday 14th & Sunday 15th September

Photos will be taken of each garden and used for the presentations.

Results will be published in the Southern Argus after the Show, and will be on display at the Strathalbyn Show on Monday October 7th, and can be picked up at 3.30pm on Show Day, when presentations are made.

CLASSES OF GARDENS

1. - Front and Back Garden
2. - Large or Rural Living Garden
3. - New Garden never previously entered in Competition
4. - Small or Restricted Garden (home unit, etc)
5. - Spick and Span, or Low Maintenance Garden
6. - Most Colourful Garden
7. - Any other type of garden (please state type on your entry form - landscaped, outdoor living area, special garden feature, cottage garden, vegetable etc.
8. - Productive Garden for home use or business use
9. - Business Presentation or Community Garden

Most Improved Garden, will be judged from all entries from 2018 Show.

Presentation of the Ross Swayne Perpetual Memorial Trophy will be made to the Grand Champion Garden in memory of the many years of dedication and support to this garden competition by Ross.

Judges Discretionary Award - Any relevant garden or a business presentation of a high standard will be eligible.
Special Prize donated by Strathalbyn Tourist Assn.

Any entrant winning Grand Champion Garden 2 years consecutively, will the following year be invited to be on the judging panel for 1 season before re-entering competition, with the entrant's garden still able to qualify for "Most Improved Garden"
